**How to Apply Online:** Review the examination bulletin at <http://jobs.ca.gov/JOBSGEN/0PB35.pdf> and the minimum qualifications. If you meet the minimum qualifications, reserve your seat for the above written examination date by scrolling to the bottom of the examination bulletin and clicking on the link to begin the Internet Self-Scheduling System.

### Minimum Qualifications

**Either I** - One year of experience in the California state service performing clerical duties at a level of responsibility equivalent to the State classification of Office Assistant (General).

**Or II** - One year of experience performing clerical, cashiering, sales clerk, or customer service work, and the equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade. (Academic education above the twelfth grade may be substituted on the basis of one year of general education being equivalent to six months of experience. Students who are enrolled in the last semester or its equivalent of course work, which upon completion will fulfill these requirements, will be admitted to the examination, but they must submit evidence of completion before being eligible for appointment.)
